


INSTRUCTIONS:


Collar Devices:

- **(Officers/Chiefs)** Long Sleeve Khaki. Center the insignia 1 inch from the front and upper edges of the collar.
- **(Officers/Chiefs)** Open Collar Short Sleeve Shirts and Navy Coveralls. Center the insignia 1 inch from the front and lower edges of the collar and position the vertical axis of the insignia along an imaginary line bisecting the angle of the collar point.
- **(E-2 to E-6)** Place collar devices at point (A) 1 inch from the front and lower edges of the collar and place the vertical axis of the insignia along an imaginary line (B) bisecting the angle of the collar point. Eagles face toward the front (inward).



- (A)**
1. Place the 'A' at the top corner of the left collar with tool parallel to collar edge.
 2. Place collar device so that it is centered at corner of tool.
 3. For the right collar the tool must be reversed so that the ruler edge is facing the collar.


- (B)**
1. Place the 'B' at the corner of the collar with dotted line bisecting the angle.
 2. Place collar device so that it is centered at edge of tool.



Garrison Cap: Cap devices and rank devices are worn on the left and right side, respectively.

- (C)**
1. Place the tool on the Garrison Cap as shown.
 2. Place collar device so that it is centered where the vertical dotted line meets the edge of the tool.
 3. For other side of the cap, place the letter 'C' at the lower corner of the cap and center the device on the corner of the tool.

Jackets: Wear regular size metal grade insignia centered on shoulder straps of blue all-weather coats, khaki jackets, blue jackets and black jackets. Place the outer edge of each device 3/4 inch from the squared end of the shoulder strap.



1. Place the tool on the Garrison Cap as shown.
2. Place collar device so that it is centered where the vertical dotted line meets the edge of the tool.
3. For other side of the cap, place the letter 'C' at the lower corner of the cap and center the device on the corner of the tool.
